

## **CORPORATE ENVIRONMENT POLICY OMDC**

- It shall be our continuous endeavor to guide and motivate our Personnel, Associates and Customers to work for Greener and Healthier Environment.
- OMDC shall review its environmental objectives and targets and continuously improve upon them and will form OMDC GREEN FORCE (OGF) which shall comply with statutory and regulatory requirement for Environmental Management.
- OMDC is also committed to continuously improve upon its environmental performance by adopting 4R PRACTICE.

### **4R PRACTICE**

**REDUCE** : The consumption of natural resources and Pollution by using latest technology.

**RECHARGE** : Human Resources by upgrading the skills through training and motivating the employees and interested parties for augmenting environmental management system and objectives.

**RECYCLE** : Waste material by using appropriate process for reuse.

**RE-USE** : Committed to utilize the waste / rain water through water harvesting scheme.

In addition to the above 4R practice, following commitments are main motto of OMDC Ltd.

- i. All waste goods, food, tyres and discarded equipment shall be disposed off at the designated waste disposal zone / site. Used oils shall be collected and disposed of properly to registered recyclers.
- ii. All legislative requirements shall be effectively complied with; updates or changes in legislation must be communicated to all employees.
- iii. Environmental Status during operational stage of Mining, ore processing and of other related plants would be ascertained periodically, monitored for changes if there are any and appropriate remedial measures would be taken.
- iv. Afforestation would be a continuing process.
